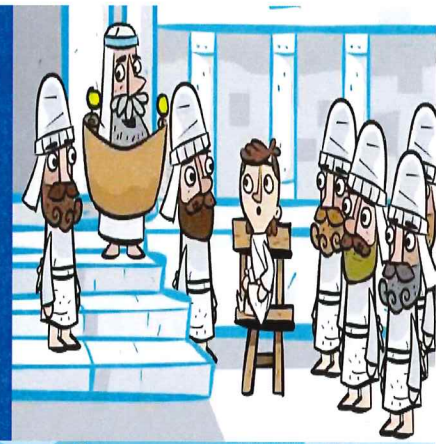


Who is he? A series on Jesus

June 2, 2019

Bible story: Young Jesus in the Temple (Luke 2:41-52)

Jesus was just 12 years old, Jesus and His parents returned to the temple for the Passover feast - something they did each year. On their way home, Mary and Joseph realized Jesus was not with them. They went back to search for Him and three days later they finally found Him in the temple sitting at the feet of religious leaders learning from their teachings. When they asked what He was doing, Jesus responded "I was about my Father's business." Even though Jesus was just a child, He knew who He was and He knew who God had created Him to be.

June 9, 2019

Bible story: Jesus Growing up (Luke 1:7, 3:1-20)

Though Jesus was fully man, He was fully God even as a child. He knew what was expected of Him and He knew the important job He would one day carry out - dying for us on the cross. But as a child, there was a lot of growing up Jesus had to do first. He experienced every part of growing up that we have and He slowed down to enjoy every moment of it, knowing that it would not last forever and one day His life would change drastically!!

June 16, 2019

Bible story: The Baptism of Jesus (Matthew 3:13-17)

Baptism is when you have the opportunity to share to the world how excited and thankful you are to receive the gift of your salvation. When Jesus asked John the Baptist to baptize him John was shocked. Jesus wanted to show an example to the world and what better way then to have John baptize him. Instantly the sky split open and the Holy Spirit came down as a dove and rested on Jesus. This was the beginning of Jesus ministry on Earth.

Bible story: The Temptation of Jesus (Mark 1:12-13)
